

## **Pupils in need of catch up in year 1 and 2 (COVID-19)**

In Years 1 & 2 we have identified pupils that have fallen behind and will benefit from the following range of intensive teaching and learning initiatives...

- Small English and maths focus groups. These small groups enable teachers or LSAs to recap work to consolidate learning
- One to one intervention. These one to one intensive sessions allow individual learning particularly in relation to reading, spelling and phonics.
- Extra support in English lessons. Junior teachers are being used to provide extra support in English lessons at least once a week.
- Improved reading scheme. The reading scheme has been updated and new books have been purchased.
- Extra reading. Those children who have fallen behind with their reading during lockdown are being heard read at least 4 times a week.
- Extra resources. Resources to enhance teaching and learning in English and maths have been purchased e.g. phonics games, practical maths equipment
- Schemes of Work. Teachers and coordinators are spending time adapting the SOW to ensure it meets the needs of the pupils.
